

## **PROSPECTUS**

### **The Congregation : The Apostolic Carmel**

The congregation of the Apostolic Carmel was founded in 1868 by Mother Veronica of the Passion in Bayonne, France and established at Mangalore, India, in 1870. Following the path of the Carmelite Tradition of St. Teresa of Avila and of Mother Veronica the Sisters try to combine in their lives contemplation with apostolic activity according to the needs of the time. The focus of their apostolic service is 'Christ in His brethren-the church and the world'.

The Congregation tries to fulfill the purpose of its existence through the education of youth in the various schools, colleges, technical training centers, Community Colleges, hostels, children's homes, crèches and schools for the differently abled, established throughout India, Sri Lanka, Kuwait, Bahrain, Pakistan and Africa. It aims at developing the students entrusted to its care into committed people who should be the leaven in their milieu, putting love and meaning into human life and endeavour.

### **The School : A Historical Note**

Fatima Convent School, a Christian Minority School, was established in 1954 in Ashok Nagar, Kanpur and administered and managed by the sisters of the Apostolic Carmel, an indigenous educational body of wide and long experience. The school belongs to the Carmel Sadan Society of U.P. The school is under the religious jurisdiction of Catholic Bishop of Allahabad.

Fatima Convent School got its affiliation to CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education), New Delhi on 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2015. The academic year begins in the month of April and consists of two terms-Summative Assessment I and Summative Assessment II.

The school aims at the education of the Catholic community around, and extends its service to members of other communities to the extent possible. The school stands for academic excellence, development of skills, and character formation based on the love of God and the service of humanity as modeled in Jesus Christ, with a view of training citizens for all round development and sincere commitment to God and country.

The object of the institution is to produce intellectually well informed, morally upright, socially concerned, emotionally-balanced and spiritually oriented women, who will act as agents of social change in their motherland and in the world of today.

#### **A. Our Vision**

Inspired by our Foundress Mother Veronica and urged on by Mother Marie des Anges our first Superior General 'we shall keep looking ahead with a clear vision for the future', for standards of excellence in our educational and social apostolate for a holistic development of our students which shall enable them to face the challenges of tomorrow.

To fulfill our vision we shall endeavour to

- instill life-promoting values through value education / faith formation with emphasis on nourishing and deepening their faith in God.

- Provide academic opportunities which will enable them to excel at the national and international level

- Promote national integration, patriotism and communal harmony through the celebration of national festivals and inter-faith prayer
- Create environmental awareness leading to the protection of natural resources along with eco-friendly organizations

- Invite and motivate all our staff members to be co-sharers in our Vision and Mission
- Call on parents and guardians who entrust their children to us, to co-operate with us to make our students a powerful force for the good of our society

## CURRICULUM

The medium of instruction is English but very special emphasis is given to Hindi, the national language, together with the essential subjects : Sanskrit, History, Geography, Social Studies, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Training, Computer Applications, Economic Applications and so on. The School has well equipped laboratories for science, modern computer labs and library to facilitate the students to develop and foster their innate talents and keep abreast with the modern education from the very beginning.

The School lays a great deal of stress on character formation and development of spiritual and ethical values which are imparted regularly to students through Joyful Living classes.

### A. RULES OF THE SCHOOL

1. Students should arrive at school 15 minutes before the Assembly. Soon after the assembly bell, the school gates will be locked and the **late comers will return home at the risk of the parents / guardians**. Participation in the morning assembly is compulsory for all in Fatima Convent School.
2. FCS Students should behave in a decent manner on their way to school. They are reminded that the school is judged by their conduct. Therefore, **Students are answerable to the school authorities not only for their conduct in the school but also for their general behaviour outside the school**. Any report on objectionable conduct on the part of the students, exposes them to disciplinary action, not excluding expulsion.

3. **English shall be spoken at all times in the school premises by the students and even while coming to school and returning.**
4. Students should take good care of their books and their personal belongings. Each article should be marked with the student's Name, Adm. No., Class and Section.
5. Students are not allowed to bring any **expensive article to school**. The school is not responsible for the goods lost.
6. **School diary should be brought to school daily.** Novels, Magazines, News papers other than those found in the School library should not be circulated in the school without the permission of the Principal.
7. No student is allowed to leave the school premises during school hours or recess without the permission of the Principal or Vice Principal. **No child will be sent home even if some urgent need arises**, unless a duly authorized person comes to fetch her with a note of authorization from the parents or guardian.
8. All students are expected to bring tiffin with them for the recess.
9. No student shall carry mobile phone, Tablets, I-Pods, Camera or any kind of electronic gadget to the school. Use of it in school campus is punishable under law. The above mentioned gadgets if found, such articles will be confiscated and will not be returned to the students. Those who break this rule will have to bear the penalties.
10. Students shall not offer gifts or presents to the members of the staff, friends or classmates.
11. Any damage done to the school property should be made good by the students concerned. A fine of Rs. 100/- will be charged in damaging the furniture, library books and other apparatus of the school.
12. All homework should be done neatly and the day's work always dated.
13. Smoking, chewing gum, chewing tobacco or pan masala and consuming alcohol is strictly forbidden in the school premises.
14. Students should treat others respectfully and are responsible for other's good name. Calling nick-name, spreading rumours, use of slang etc. are strictly forbidden, and are liable to strict disciplinary action.
15. Students are to address their teachers and all members of the school with respect and politeness.
16. Every student is expected to subscribe to small charities if requested by the Principal. However no fines, funds or collections are to be made in the school without the written permission or notice from the Principal.
17. Physical Education is compulsory. Exemption will be allowed only on production of a Medical Certificate. It is compulsory for every student to take part in curricular and co-curricular activities organized by the school.
18. **Girls must tie their hair neatly in two plaits with black ribbons with centre or side parting (No puff allowed). They will wear a white knee length slip under their uniform.**

19. Personal cleanliness is very essential. The fingernails should be trimmed, and the shoes be polished daily. Wristwatch, bangles, hair pin, rings, colour ear rings, ornaments, jewellery, nail polish, mehndi, hair colouring etc. are not allowed in the School for any class.
20. Wearing of uniform at school every day is compulsory for all. A student who is not properly dressed and groomed may be excluded from the class or sent back home. They should therefore be provided with sufficient sets of uniforms.
21. When pupils go from one class to another they must move in silence. They are never to leave the class without the permission of the teacher, nor the school premises without the permission of the Principal.

## **B. REGULARITY RECORD**

22. Regular and punctual attendance is insisted upon. Unauthorized absence from the school is not tolerated except in sudden illness or unforeseen circumstances. Students should not absent themselves from school without previous permission in writing. Should absence on account of ill health or due to unforeseen circumstances which may exceed two or three days, a leave application should be sent to the Principal, without which the student will not be admitted to class.
23. Pupils have to return to School promptly after the holidays and those who are absent for a month without prior information, will have their names stuck off the rolls. In case of sickness, notify the Principal on the same day with relevant medical documents. Students should be present on the first and last day of each school term.
24. Admission to the class for absentees is granted only when they show the class teacher the Application/Regularity Record duly countersigned by the Principal / Vice Principal.
  - If absent for one/two days enter the reason in the regularity record and show only to Class Teacher.
  - If the leave is for more than two days the regularity record has to be first shown to the Class Teacher and then to the Principal/ Vice Principal.
25. All leave must be applied for in writing to the Principal. **NO STUDENT SHALL PROCEED ON LEAVE WITHOUT SANCTION AND PERMISSION, SPECIALLY WHEN THE LEAVE EXCEEDS 2 DAYS.** Such reasons as birthdays, excursions, festivals, weddings, urgent business, preparation for examination are not considered sufficient.
26. If any unauthorized **ABSENCE EXCEEDS TEN CALENDAR DAYS**, the defaulter's **NAME WILL BE STRUCK OFF THE ROLLS** and considered withdrawn.
27. No transfer certificate will be issued to the student without clearing the dues.
28. Early departure from school to be entered in the space provided for in the school diary.

## **C. PUNCTUALITY**

29. School begins at 7.20 a.m. Students should be inside the gate by 7.15 a.m. after which the gates will be closed. **The late comers will not be allowed to enter in.**
30. Submission of projects, note books should be as instructed by the teacher. On late submission, the teacher is not entitled to mark the students.

## D. EXAMINATION & PROMOTION

31. a. There are two major examinations for classes K.G to XII in a year, i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Terms besides periodic assessments and class test. The pass mark is 40%.  
b. There are two major examinations for class X and XII in a year, i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Terms, besides Pre-Boards, internal assessments, Unit Tests and regular class tests. The pass mark is 35%.
32. Parents are requested to clear all the dues (School fees, library & laboratory dues etc.) before the Terminal Examination. In clearance of all dues an Admit Card will be issued, which the students should bring daily to school & during the days of examination.
33. Please do not send any sick child for any test/exam. **If any child does not attend the school for the entire day on any unit test/exam day, the marks of that day's subject will not reflect in the progress report.**
34. Promotion is given on the basis of one year's work and not merely on marks scored in the exams. Every student must be present for all the major exams. The average of these is taken at the end of the year. Total aggregate of 40% in each subject is a precondition for promotion. Class work and home work are also assessed and awarded with the internal assessment.
35. Each student is required to be present for **80% of school days** as a pre-condition for promotion and to appear for the CBSE examination.
36. **There shall be neither anticipation nor postponement of any tests or examination nor re-test nor re-examination.**
37. Any cheating or breach of any of the regulations for the conduct of the examinations is punishable even with cancelling of paper or no marks will be allotted to that particular paper. Strict action will be taken against those who resort to unfair means in the examinations.
38. If a pupil does not pass in all subjects, all concessions will be cancelled.
39. The evaluated answer script and other work done by the students are within the jurisdiction of the school and therefore an outside person or authority has no right to check, scrutinize or claim back the answer scripts or any work done by the students. Answer scripts are retained in the school only for a month after publishing the results.
40. Evaluated answer scripts are shown to the parents after the PA I & II and Term 1 examination. Answer papers of final examination will not be, under any circumstances, shown or returned.
41. The students must be present on School Result day. On clearance of all dues the Report Card will be handed over to the students. The result will be with-held if any fees are due to the school.
42. The result declared at the end of the year is final and cannot be reconsidered. In all matters of promotion or failure the Principal's decision is final.

## E. ADMISSION

43. Candidates for admission to all classes must pass an Entrance Examination, A Transfer Certificate from the school last attended shall be presented at the time of admission to UKG and above.
44. The admission form will have to be filled in and all the preliminary fees paid on the day of admission. A valid Birth Certificate is to be submitted at the time of admission. **No change in the name and date of Birth** is permitted later.
45. Every candidate for admission must be introduced in person to the Principal by the parents.
46. The age required for admission to LKG is 3½ years and above. An interaction of both the parents together with child is required.
47. (a) Guardians are expected to fill in the admission form with utmost accuracy. No subsequent change will be permitted thereafter for any reason.  
(b) There is **no automatic admission to Std. XI from Std. X**. Admission is purely based on one's performance in the school, discipline, and obedience during the previous school years.

## **F. WITHDRAWAL AND EXPULSION**

48. A month's notice in writing is required before withdrawing a student from the school or a month's fees paid.
49. No school leaving certificate (T.C) will be issued unless requested in writing by the parent and all the fees and dues are cleared in full. Fees, so long as a pupil's name is on the roll, have to be paid. **A fees of Rs. 200/- will be charges for the transfer certificate and Rs. 50/- for all other certificates issued from the school.**
50. The Principal reserves the right to take disciplinary action against the students, whose attendance is irregular, who do not pay their fees, who are habitually absent, lazy, dishonest or disobedient, who fail to make satisfactory progress in their studies or whose conduct in any way is detrimental to the discipline of the institution; of immorality, or whose sickness is prone to be contagious/ injurious to other students.
51. After taking admission in any class, if a student absents for 10 continuous days, the name will be struck off the rolls.

## **G. FEES**

52. The School fees covering the twelve calendar months will be paid as per fee schedule. No reduction is made for holidays or broken periods. Pupils are liable to be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls.
  - For Classes LKG & UKG Fees will be deposited at South Indian Bank, 80 Feet Road, Kanpur
  - For classes I to XII fees will be deposited at Bank of Baroda Ashok Nagar, Kanpur
  - The School Fees on quarterly basis will be accepted as per details given below :
    - April, May & June to be paid together in the month of April, from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>.
    - July, August & September to be paid together in the month of July, from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>.
    - October, November & December to be paid together in the month of October, from 1<sup>st</sup>

to 10<sup>th</sup>.

- January, February & March to be paid together in the month of January, from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>.

53. If a child is withdrawn for any length of time and the parents wish her to be re-admitted, the admission fee will be charged again.
54. Parents will kindly save the fee receipts issued to them for counter checking by the school office.
55. Every year there will be an increase of Composite and examination fees by 10-15% in order to pay the just salary to our staff members. There is a rise of cost in the maintenance. Therefore, we need funds to see to the maintenance and all-round development of your ward. The school reserves the right to revise the fees without prior notice.
56. The fee defaulters may be debarred from examinations and are liable to have their names struck off the rolls.

## **H. RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE PARENTS**

57. Parents and guardians are requested to co-operate with the school authorities in all matters concerning formation and education of their child. Parents are to look into the school diary every day and see to it that lessons and homework assigned for the next day are done. Communication made in the diary by the Principal or the teachers should be seen and countersigned.
58. Parent Teacher meeting is an important day, kindly present yourself with prudent and courteous manner. One to one representation is permitted. Follow up the reports which keep you informed of the diligence in studies and the behavior of your wards. Parents are to encourage their children to take part in the co-curricular activities of the school.
59. All communications are to be addressed to the Principal. Parents will settle any matter concerning their ward through personal meeting with the principal. No representation of other person is permitted. Criticism of child's teacher or the school in the presence of the child should be avoided as it is likely to affect their good name.
60. Parents are not allowed to come in groups or mob to pressurize the Principal on any issue. Before complaining to the Head office your personal intimation to the Principal will be highly appreciated.
61. Any damage caused to the school property or anything goes against the reputation of the school, students will be expelled.
62. Parents maintain proper decorum of courteous and prudent behavior in correspondence with the Principal's office, school clerical office counter and with the school faculty. If the parents have any grievance against any of the staff, they are advised to meet the Principal and settle the matter amicably.
63. We do not recommend that parents engage private tutors unnecessarily. We discourage tuitions since they may prove harmful to the real progress of the student.
64. Parents are always welcome to meet the Principal to discuss the progress of their children during Principal's office hours. To consult the teachers regarding the progress of their

children, appointment is to be made through the Principal or the Vice-Principal for the free time of teachers or after class hours.

65. Please urge your wards to be regular and punctual in attendance and insist on neatness and cleanliness of their text books, exercise books and personal appearance.
66. No parent /guardian is allowed to go into any classroom or go upstairs without the specific permission from school authorities.
67. The parents are requested not to give their cell phones for the use of the school students while visiting the school.
68. Attendants who bring children to school must come respectably dressed and leave the school immediately.

## **I. LIBRARY**

69. Strict silence shall be observed in the library.
70. Issue of books may at any time be suspended by the order of the Principal.
71. Students are to make good use of the School library. Books should be covered and used.
72. All the students of VI to XII may borrow books from the library. Each student can borrow one book at a time for 7/15 days.
73. Students who fail to return the books on time will be fined ten rupee per day.
74. If any book to be borrowed is damaged it should be brought to the notice of the librarian before leaving the counter.
75. Periodicals, Dictionaries and other costly books are only for reference in the library.
76. All books taken from the library should be returned two weeks before the examination.
77. No student who has dues to the library will be issued any book till the dues are paid.
78. No fiction books will be issued to the students 15 days before the examination.
79. All articles and personal belongings must be left outside when entering the library.
80. No subscriptions should e raised or raffle tickets etc. sold in the school without the permission of the principal.

## **J. THE SCHOOL UNIFORM**

School believes in the sacred responsibility of inculcating in the pupils a sense of neatness and adjustment. On the school days and at the school functions the students have to come neatly and immaculately dressed in their school uniform which is as follows:

- **DURING SUMMER:**

**Class L.K.G & U.K.G**

A Special outfit (contact School authorities), black shoes and white socks (knee length)

**Class I to V**

Blue pinafore (smoke blue, Skirt Code: 91 S. Kumar) and white blouse short sleeved (White shirt code: 6633 S. Kumar)- with school monogram, black ribbon, black shoes and white socks with double blue rims. (knee length)



### **Class VI to X**

Blue pleated skirt (smoke blue, Skirt Code: 91 S. Kumar) and white blouse (White shirt code: 6633 S. Kumar)- with school monogram, black ribbon, black shoes and white socks with double blue rims. (knee length)

### **Class XI & XII**

Salwar suit with navy blue pants and koti, with black bellies.

### **Class I to X**

**Every Wednesday** the students except for LKG and UKG will come to school in P.T. Uniform Complete white dress ((White divided skirt and blouse with school monogram; White keds and white socks)

**Every Saturday** in the House colour uniform (Yellow / Red / Green / Blue T – Shirt with pants.

Black shorts to be worn daily.

- **DURING WINTER:**

1. Chilli red pullover full ad half with double blue and white ribs with school monogram for standard I-V.
2. Chilli red cardigans, pullover full/half with double blue and white ribs with school monogram for class VI-IX.
3. Navy blue blazers for class XI & XII.
4. Black slacks to be worn daily and White slacks to be worn on Wednesday.

- Those who have long hair it should be divided into two plaits, tying them up neatly.
- All the students should present themselves clean and neatly dressed in school uniform every day. Parents will kindly provide sufficient sets of uniform.
- Style and fashion are not permitted in the school, silver & gold ornaments are not allowed, only the black hair clips or bands should be worn in the school, not the colourful ones.
- Simplicity is the hallmark of our students, therefore Mehndi, Kajal, Nail Polish, Bindi on foreheads are not permitted in the school.

### **We expect our students :**

- To be friendly with one another in and out of School
- To avoid vulgarity in their talk and behaviour and thus uphold the dignity as Fatima Convent students
- To accept whatever work is assigned to them as their rightful share.
- To offer help to any unattended visitor they happen to meet in the School premises
- To rise when any Sister, Teacher or Visitor enters or passes through any room in which they happen to be

- To greet their teachers, all the members of the staff and elders wherever they meet
- To be courteous and sportsman like with opposing teams and with officials
- To respect the library and rights of other students using it
- To respect the beauty of the School premises and to report any damage which they may observe
- To avoid dropping papers in the School premises and to pick up any paper dropped by others
- To learn and observe good manners everywhere
- To desist from writing or drawing on the black board, from writing or soiling the walls and furniture
- To speak well of the School, Management, Teachers and Schoolmates
- To move gracefully and silently from the classroom to play ground, labs, hall and return in the same manner
- To submit at the office any valuables found in the campus
- To make the School Campus a place of happy interaction and joyful growing
